An extensive underground exploration and development program is planned by Edward Anderson, E. B. Hall and Archie Farnsworth, Medford, Oregon, recent acquirers of the Cherry Gulch gold properties in the old Vicksburg district near Denio, Oregon. The new operators also intend to enlarge mill capacity to between 30 and 50 tons. Developed by 2,000 feet of tunnels and lateral workings, the claims are said to contain some 30,000 tons of good milling ore.
