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CRACKERJACK CLAIM (copper)

Ashland area

Location: sec. 14, T. 39 S., R. 1 W.

History: "The Cracker jack claim is about 3 miles southwest from Ashland and about 600 feet southeast of the Pilgrim. It is opened by a crosscut at an elevation of about 3,000 feet and by an incline shaft about 75 feet higher up. The vein strikes N. 10° W. and dips 55° S. W. The country rock is a metamorphosed sandy shale, now containing layers of quartz separated by layers of zoisite and some pale green hornblende, with some disseminated calcite and a few isolated crystals of chalcopyrite, films of bornite and rare pyrite."
