Dear Mr. Barlow:

I have completed a preliminary report on your Double Jack Mine but lack information on production. Could you estimate what the total production has been for the mine since first worked by Anderson? A breakdown of production periods and locations of ore mined would help if you can get it.

I screened the sample of concentrates you gave me, then carefully panned out all the amalgam and free gold. I weighed the gold from the concentrate at 0.4 gram and calculated the recovered value at about 20 ounces per ton. The concentrate you gave me was contaminated with some kind of bearing metal, so I did not send it in for assay.

As soon as I get the production information from you, I will send along a copy of the preliminary report.
