Location: The claims were located in February 1962 on the ridge top about 3900 feet elevation in sec. 33, T. 33 S., R. 4 W. The area is reached via the Evans Creek, Pleasant Creek, Ditch Creek roads and 2½ mile jeep trail which connects with the Ditch Creek road at a point just north of Grave Creek divide. Distance to the railroad at Rogue River is about 20 miles.

Development: Work is limited to shallow bulldozer cuts.

Geology: A few narrow lenses and seams of tremolite in serpentine are exposed in the cuts. Nothing extensive was seen in the brief visit to the area.
