Dear Mr. Breeding:

I am sending you a copy of the assay returns on the sample I obtained from your bulk tunnel sample and a copy of the brief report which I wrote as a result of our visit to the prospect May 24, 1956. It is my opinion that the only chance for this prospect would be to find sufficient amounts of the higher grade copper ore. I don't think there is much likelihood of developing any large tonnage of copper ore of sufficient grade to ship. It would be necessary to hand sort and selectively mine the high-grade lenses of sulphide. They are probably too few and far between to be handled on a commercial basis.

I would appreciate hearing of the results of any further development work on this prospect in the event any further work is done.
