Owner and Operators: A. N. and George H. Johnson, Route 1, Rogue River, Oregon.

Location: 16 miles from north of Rogue River on Pleasant Creek in Sec. 15, T. 34 S., R. 4 W.

Area: 150 acres patented.

Water right: Water right taken out in 1862. Season is from November 1st to June 1st. $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles ditch, 25 c.f.s. 28 foot head.

Production: \$4500 produced under present ownership.

Equipment: 1 - No. 1 Giant, 480 ft. of 8, 10 and 11 inch pipe.

Geology: There is very little clay, some big boulders; coarse gold. 30 acres mined, 40 acres left, 13 feet gravel. No overburden. Big boulders moved by hand. Flat operation. There is a high line ditch, but it costs too much to fix up.
