Owner and operator: H. B. Scott, R. F. D. Box 102, Rogue River, Oregon.

Location: 17 miles north of Rogue River on Pleasant Creek. Sec. 10, T. 34 S., R. 4 W.

Area: 180 acres. 80 acres of it ~~was~~ deeded and 100 acres is held by location.

History: This is an old mine but the present owner knows very little about its past history and there is no record of yardage moved or production.

Water right: 28 second feet in Pleasant Creek and near by gulches. Four and one-half miles of ditch gives 150 feet head. The season is November until May 15th.

Geology: Hillside operation. No boulders but red material, granite bedrock. No development. Last winters operations indicate about 25% per yard average. Maximum  $3\frac{1}{2}$  feet of snow. Elevation 1600 ft.

Equipment: No. 1 giant and 1000 feet of 11 inch pipe.
