Due to a low water supply, the Southern Oregon Mining Company has temporarily suspended dredging operations on Forest Creek near Ruch, Oregon. Work has been under the direction of John D. Bowdish, 1260 Sunset, Medford, Oregon. Equipment at the mine has a capacity of 100 yards an hour and includes a Bodinson dredge, 352 Marion dragline with a 1 1/4-yard Page and 1 1/4-yard Esco bucket.
