ROGERS PROPERTY (gold, beryllium)

Gold Hill Area

Located on the Umpqua-Rogue River divide at 5400 feet elevation; developed by two short tunnels. Assays of samples sent by owner had values up to \$26.00 gold and 10 percent beryllium. It also is reported to have other peculiar disagreeable odors with injurious affects upon persons and bleaching affects upon blue prints. Reported by George Schumacher, Medford, Oregon.
