had priority since 1866.

Geology: Very little clay, lots of boulders, rough bed rock.  
Elevation 1500 feet.

Equipment: Some make shift testing equipment.

General Information: Mr. Rose states his ground will run 50¢  
a yard, coarse and fine gold.
