Present Owner - Fred Bacon Jr. P.O. Box 16, Gold Hill, Oregon.

History: - The original discoverer is not known. J. S. Dillen reports the Owl Hollow Prospect as active and some development being done before 1914. It is reported that ~~the~~ the brothers Robinson of Rogue River found a pocket at the surface (#14,000). There are two caved glory holes and several hand dug cuts where this pocket was reported to have been found. Winchell in the summer of 1913 listed the Owl Hollow Mine but reported that it has been inactive for several years.

Veteran claim were owned by Peter Borjick during the 1940's (Assessment records date from 2/10/41 to 3/1/49) Borjick reported to have actually mined and milled from workings <sup>near</sup> below the old Owl Hollow. No records of production.

Made a Brunton - tape sketch of workings - recommended <sup>sample</sup> of stopes in present workings, before planning development of any kind of mill.

Geology: Country rocks = greenstone  
NW striking vein nearly vertical broken qtz in shear  
where stoped 3 to 4 feet wide  
some pyrite disseminated through greenstone.

Country rocks are metavolcanics, in some places appear to have originally been tuff breccias; also some amygdaloidal basalts, most rocks are fractured + sheared.

Visited property with J. W. Bradley, Aug. 8/30/72. Checked the lower tunnel which had been opened and found new work had been done since Oct. 1963. Took 1 sample of clay gouge and altered rock from a sheared zone near the bottom of the raise in lower tunnel, looked over the surface workings and old pits. Penned one sample from near old glory hole workings.
