MEDFORD, May 17.—(Special)—
Work is progressing satisfactorily at
the Black Bear mine east of Phoenix
and production of coal is averaging
two tons a day, it was stated today
by L. L. Davis, general manager.
The enterprise has taken the busi-
ness name of United Coal company.

Two men have been added to the
crew of workers and the staff and
production will be augmented when
the face of the mine is reached, Mr.
Davis said.

The mine was visited last week by
J. E. Morrison, geologist of the state
board of geology and mineral indus-
try. He said he would visit the mine
again when operations are farther
along, Mr. Davis related.
