Arthur J. Champion, long a familiar figure in the Prineville-Ochoco Mtns area, died the week of October 17th, '48. He was 66 years old. Was born in Michigan. He came to the Ochoco area in 1909 where he followed his training as saw mill operator and woodsman for years.

His first venture in mining apparently was at the Mayflower gold mine. He and partners made stakes there in the interval between 1916 and 1923.

He is credited with the discovery of several of the cinnabar prospects and mines in the Ococo district. He and partners operated some of them.

His greatest discovery was the finding of the Horse Heaven Mine. This was discovered by "Art" and his partner, Grover Keating, after an extensive panning campaign in 1933.

Champion and partner, a Mr. Hunt of Portland, operated the Mother Lode cinnabar mine during the years 1940-1941.

Of late years his natural longing to prospect for cinnabar and gold was prevented by ill health.
