January 22, 1944

According to reports, the B-H Company of Medford, Oregon, has filed notice of dissolution. The company, T. M. Gerety, Box 1091, Medford, president and general manager, formerly operated a dragline dredge and Diesel-powered Bodinson washer on Forest Creek in Jackson County near Medford and employed about 15 men. Holdings included the Alaska of Oregon, Christian-Dobbins, Green, and Sturgis groups of gold placer claims.

A crew of 15 men are employed by the **B-H Company** at Medford, Oregon, operating a dragline dredge on the Sturgis mine which handles about 2,000 yards of gravel daily. T. M. Gerety of Medford is president and general manager and Harry C. Skyrman, also of Medford, is secretary. Gold and silver values are recovered.
