Name: Cloudy Day Quartz Claim (Gold)

Owner: J. L. Tyson, Star Route, Jacksonville, Oregon

Location: On Brush Creek. $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles northwest of Copper and 39 miles southwest of Medford. In about the center of the west half of Sec. 16, T. 40 S., R. 4 W.

Area: One full size quartz claim of 20 acres.

History: This claim was formerly owned by George Siple. A number of small gold pockets have been found on the property.

Geology: Country rock greenstone which is cut by an andesite dike. Fractures in the greenstone at their intersection with the dike produce gold. The fractures run in an east-west direction.

Misc. Information: One tunnel 100 feet long running in a northerly direction, and two shafts 20 feet each, are inaccessible at the present time. Elevation 3200 ft. No timber or water on claim. Water can be developed on Brush Creek. No equipment. Mountainous topography. Maximum 4 feet of snow.
