A portable Judson-Pacific gold recovery plant with a Lima dragline and 1½-yard Esco bucket are used. The floating plant is Diesel powered. After working the ground the company resells it, according to lease agreement. The property was formerly worked by Charles Dalerup and Joseph H. Garner of San Francisco. Francis Thomas, Box 1055, Medford, is superintendent of present operations and L. V. Riddle of Medford is chief engineer. John Daniel of the Daniel Contracting Company, 503 Market Street, San Francisco, is vice-president.

Top Soil Suit Filed at Medford

MEDFORD, March 20.—(Special) —Suit was filed Wednesday by John Matney and wife of the Ruch district against the Crescent-Pacific Mining company, for alleged failure to comply with an agreement covering the mining on property three miles from Ruch. The complaint seeks the replacing of top soil and its leveling, per agreement, and which, it is claimed, has not been done.

In lieu of not replacing the soil, \$1,750 is sought as cost of resoiling, and \$1,500 for use of the land. Attorneys George M. Roberts and Victor A. Tengwald represent the Matneys.
