General Information: Country rock is porphyry. 15 tunnels.

All but 3 are caved. No record of production
but estimated to be approximately \$5,000. Usually
produces a little every year. It has been worked
on the idea that it would be a large low grade
property. A number of assays have been taken on
the property but they do not tell anything as they
do not show any widths or location from where

they came etc.
