"Wright and Myer have a mine 3 miles northwest of Steamboat in the SW-4 sec. 17, T. 40 S., R. 4 W., at an elevation of about 3200 feet as measured by barometer. An adit crosscuts 30 feet to a vein which is followed 70 feet N. 60° W. The vein contains a little chalcopyrite and is said to average \$28 in gold per ton. Pyrite disseminated in the andesite wall rock is said to carry \$16 a ton in gold and very little copper. The vein plays out upward but the surface workings are on a vein dipping 50° N.E. while the lower vein dips 75° S.W. Adjoining claims have ore containing arsenopyrite, pyrrhotite, and chalcopyrite in quartz. Wright and Myer have a 2-stamp mill with an 8-foot plate and one jig operated by a gasoline engine."
