Name: Freckles(Gold placer).

Owner: Edwin L. Davis, Wonder, Oregon

Location: On Waters Creek two and one-half miles from Highway No. 199 and is the West one-half of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 32, T. 36 S., R. 7 W.

Area: Twenty acres.

General Information: The claim is at the mouth of Long John Creek, a tributary to Waters Creek. Five test holes have been dug and show that there is a small channel on the east side of Long John Creek. Three to five feet of alluvial gravel. Argillite bed rock which stands on edge making an irregular bedrock. No water right. Water can be secured from Waters Creek, but it is doubtful if it can be secured under any head. Elevation 1300 ft. Maximum 12 inches of snow. Mr. Davis seems to think he could make a living ground sluicing during the winter months.
