Sorry for the long delay in getting returns on the assays; but here they are at last. The sample APG-17 looks interesting; but the quartz samples are a little too "hungry".

I have been canvassing as many gold miners as possible to get a total figure of gold production for 1980 and 1981. The U.S. Bureau of Mines figures reported for Oregon are completely ridiculous. So far it looks like Southwestern Oregon production has had a significant contribution to the economy by the many small producers. It adds up to new wealth in the area; but hasn't been given proper credit for its importance.

If you have produced any gold during 1980 and 1981, I'd like to get your figures. They will be kept strictly confidential and no one's individual production will be given out. We will publish only a total figure for these two years, provided we get a reasonably complete report.
