Deadlines Approach For Extending Mining Claims

Under new regulations published on December 15, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will accept statements of annual proof of labor or notice of intent to hold mining claims if postmarked by midnight December 30, 1982 and received in the proper BLM office by January 19, 1983. Hand delivered filings must be received by December 30.

Heretofore, statements needed to maintain existing mining claims on federal lands had to be actually received by BLM by December 30.

Statements of assessment work or notices of intent to hold mining claims in Oregon and Washington must be filed with the Oregon State Office, Bureau of Land Management, 825 NE Multnomah Street, P.O. Box 2965, Portland, OR 97208.

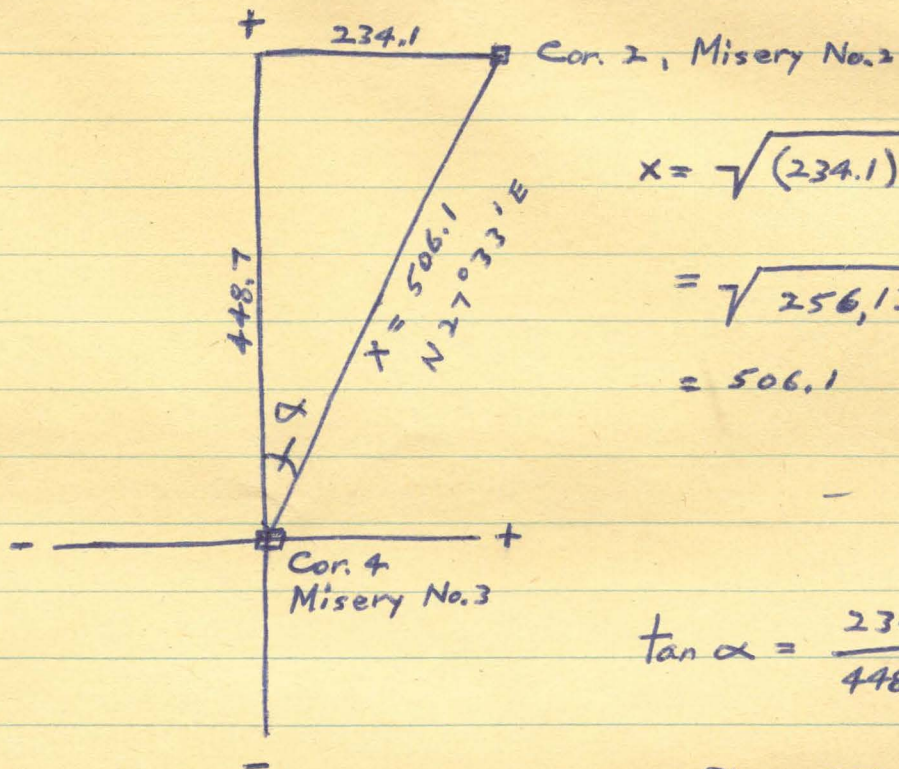
BLM's Portland office hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. Monday through Friday. To assist the public, BLM will also receive hand delivered annual filings on December 30 between 4:15 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the Bonneville Power Administration Building at 1002 NE Holladay Street, Portland, Oregon.

Failure to file the required statements invalidates claims.

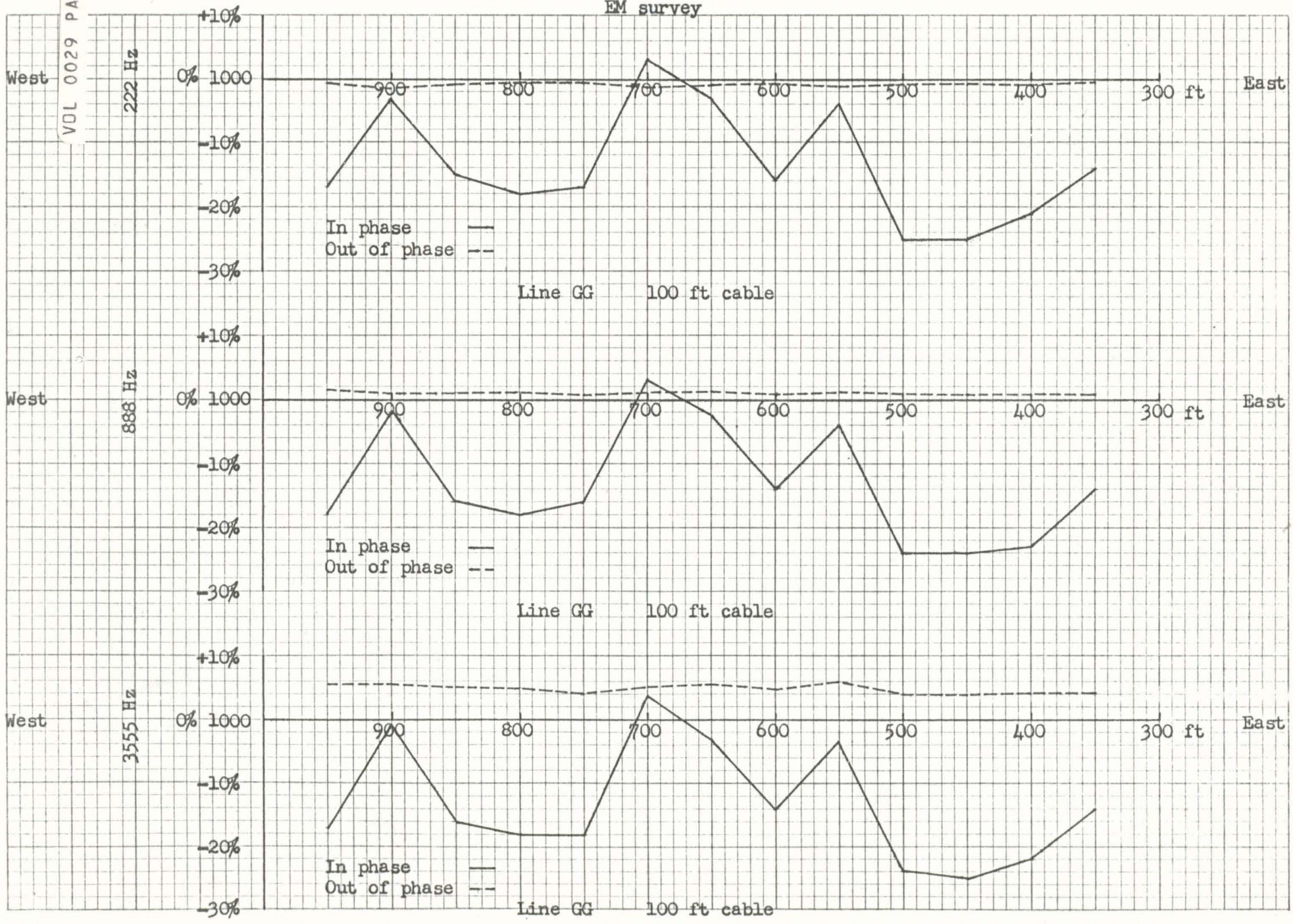

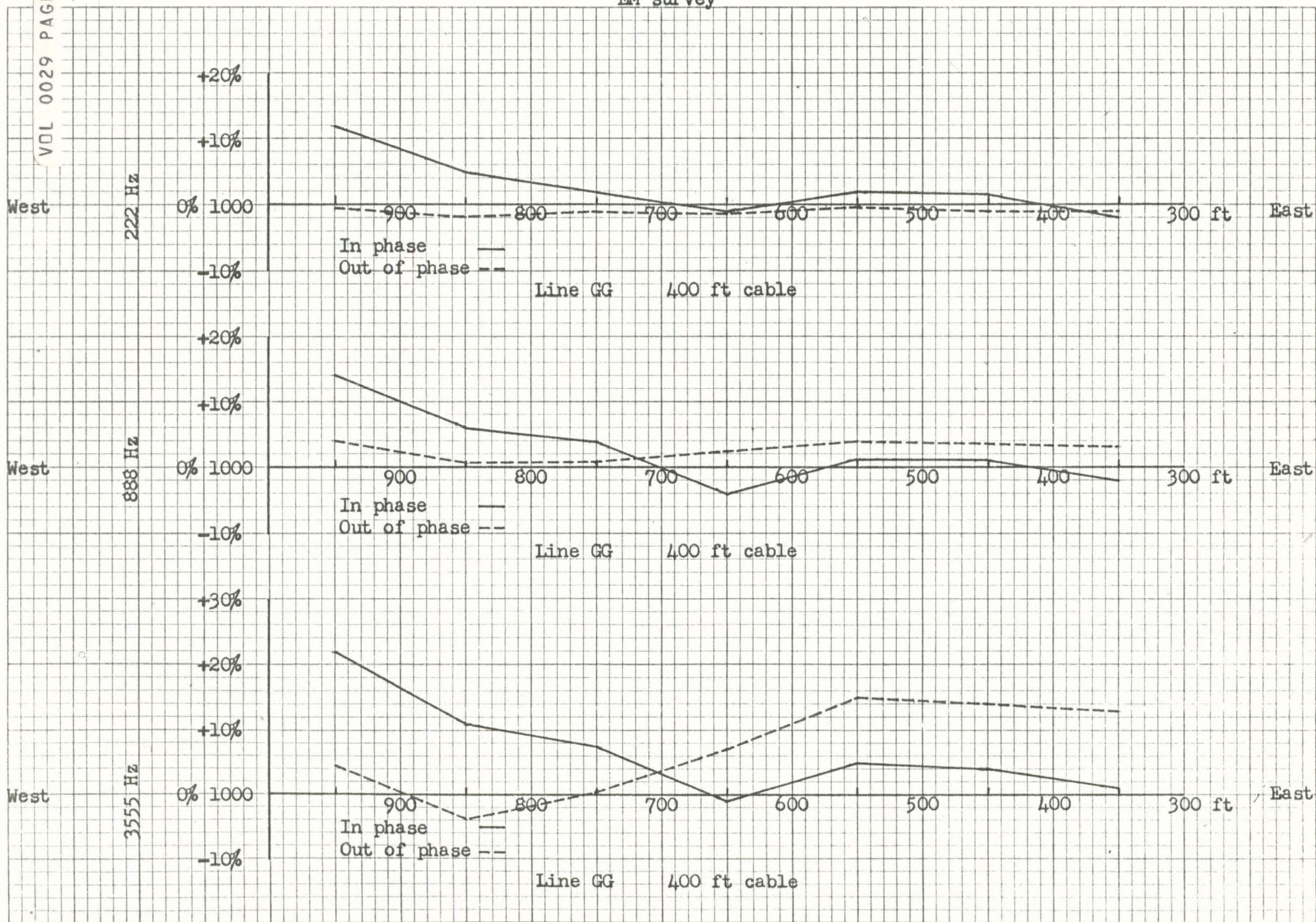

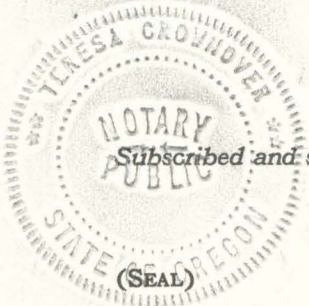
