I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th, asking for information on some of my mineral lands in Josephine County.

The Vindicator Mine which you referred to, belongs to me, but I would suggest that you get in touch with Virgil Goff of Leland, Oregon, for the desired information. He has worked in this mine practically every since its opening and lives near there. He can give you more information than any one else.

I do not have any information on the Magnolia Claim in Section 24, Twp. 34 S., Range 8 W.

I have a number of other mineral properties, these being located as follows:

 $SW_{4}^{\frac{1}{2}}$  of Section 2, Twp. 35 S., Range 5 W., knows as part of the Orpheno Groupe.

120 acres in Section 32, this being the  $N_{\frac{1}{2}}$  of the  $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$  and the  $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$  of the  $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ , Twp. 33 S., Range 7 W.

There are some good indications on a 280 acre tract in Section 34 and 347 acres in Section 23, Twp. 35 S., Range 7 W.

The  $\mathbb{W}_{2}^{1}$  of Section 18, Twp. 34 S., Range 6 W. and  $\mathbb{N}\mathbb{W}_{4}^{1}$  of Section 20.
