GOLD HILL AREA

Manganese occurs as replacement in quartzite and is derived from rhodonite. Outcrops range from 2060 - 2520 feet in elevation over a width of several hundred feet. Some ore was taken out during the first World War and piled alongside the Evans Creek road, but the ore was never shipped.
