Descriptions:

RG-352 - from small bleached gouge seam in decomposed diorite in lower part of large cut. (about 6 inches)

RG-353 - similar seam (1 inch) from point near old winge dug by Woolfolk. Both samples are largely quartz and clay (weathered feldspar) with minor manganese stain.

RG-354 - weathered dolerite (?) dike from shallow dozer trench above and east of main cut.
