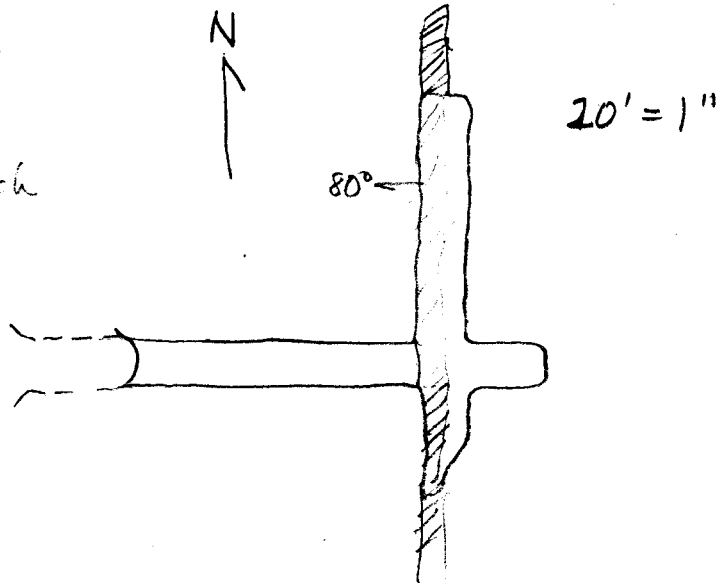


Dunlap Prospect (Greenback claim)

1000' N25°E of Gold Butte L.O.  
about same el. as saddle to E. of tunnel, at end of  
L.O. road.

Zone 6" - 18" wide  
of reddish cherty quartz,  
with in part oxidized sulphides  
very sparse, some secondary  
comb quartz. Country rock  
gray andesite-tuff.
