Referring to your letter of July 25th addressed to Mr. Kruttschnitt enclosing report on the Forsyth placer mine, Josephine County, Oregon.

I note that Mr. W. W. Hurt makes no reference in his report as to the exact location of the mine he has described. He does not even mention on what river or creek this property is located. I have made a great number of investigations of placer properties in Josephine County and have thoroughly sampled a number of them and must frankly admit that I have considerable doubt that any such property as described by Mr. Hurt exists in Josephine County. By this I mean the values that he claims. I cannot see the logic of his guessing the ground will awarage 50 cents to the cubic yard when he states it will prospect 20 cents to the cubic yard at grass roots and \$8.00 per cubic yard at bed rock. As a matter of fact part of his report reads like a dime novel.
