Gentlemen:

Yesterday I visited your property, the "Turvey Limestone" placer mining claim located in Josephine County Oregon, being in fact the East half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 38 South Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian, as surveyed and staked by Mr. Glen C. Hunter.

This limestone outcrop at the lower exposed end is, by the aneroid barometer, 1000 feet higher than the county road at its nearest point at the Turvey place, which is a little over a half mile distance in a direct line. This fact necessitates the building of a road from the property to the county road and in my estimation, it should be 4 miles long in order to keep the average grade close to 5 per cent. The county road is passable in winter as is the state road, giving a total haul of about 25 miles into Grants Pass.

The limestone outcrop is of excellent material and is clear of overburden for the amount shown. The sketch and crossection will give you information as to its shape and dimensions as well as its position.

To facilitate the estimation of the tonnage I divided the outcrop into three sections. Block "A" contains about 50,000 tons, "B" about 50,000 tons and "C" about 25,000 tons, all being exposed. By removing overburden and by carrying the quarry floor of block "B" and block "C" at the same elevation as block "A", the tonnage of these last two blocks would be doubled and trippled respectively.

This preliminary report is brief due to the lack of sufficient time to study the many features of the property but I do believe you can gain much information from the enclosed "Township" map, "Sketch" and "Crossection".
