On June 9, 1938 I visited the Calumet property which is sometimes known as the Albright and is now owned by Mrs. Carrie E. G. Elder.


At the time of my visit the tunnels were caved and most of the open-out exposures were so sloughed that it was impossible to make any more than a casual examination.

A Resume of Diller's Report is on Page 49 of Vol. 2, No. 4 of the Mineral Resources of Oregon. On the dump of the 500 foot tunnel there is approximately 5 tons of quartz. A grab sample went \$16.10 in gold (\$35.00), indicating that there must have been ore found some place.

On the west side of the mountain there are two short tunnels which I believe should be very closely examined.
