DEER CREEK, NO. 1

Illinois River area
Josephine County

Owners: Dale R. Tucker and John Pope
Location notice dated August 20, 1937.

Location: Sec. 33, T. 38S, R. 6W; 34 miles from Grants Pass,
21 miles of pavement, 10 miles of Forest Service road, and 3 miles
of trail.

History: The property is marked as Number 75 on the Grants
Pass Geological Map. It lies on the south slope of the South Fork
of Deer Creek, at an elevation of 3100 feet. Little work has been
done on the deposit.

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DEER CREEK, NO. 2

Waldo area
Josephine County

Owners: Unknown.

Location: Sec. 4, T. 39S, R. 4W; 34½ miles from Grants Pass; 21 miles pavement, 10 miles Forest Service road, 3½ miles trail. The property lies on a ridge between a northward flowing creek and the South Fork of Deer Creek, at an altitude of 3850 feet.

History: This property is marked on the Grants Pass Geological Map as Number 76. There has been little development work and little or no production.
