approximately 30 ft. above Josephine creek

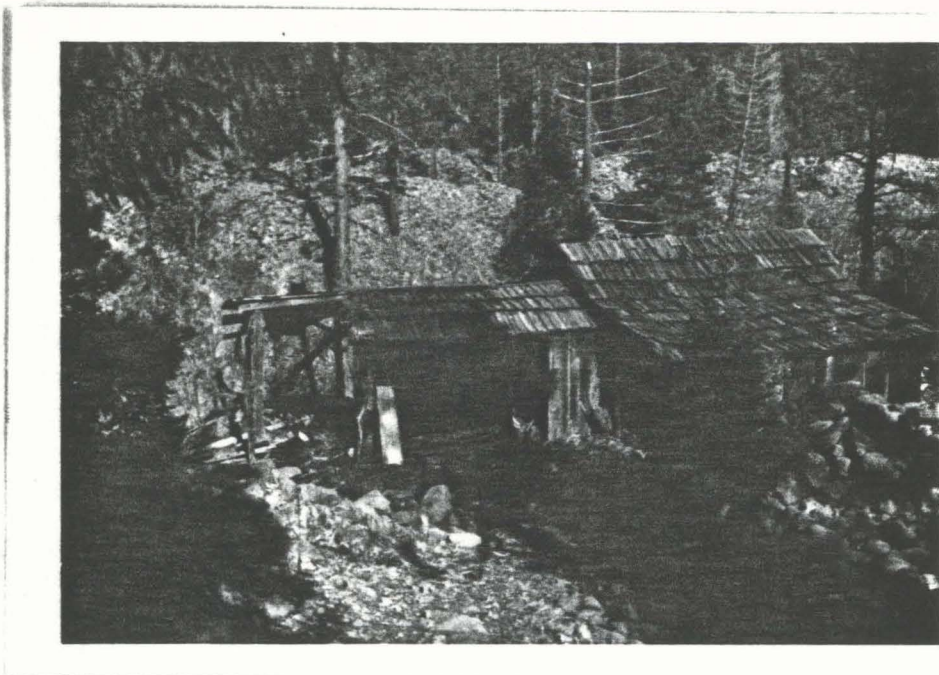
General valuation: The ground comprising the claim has been thoroughly worked as shown

is no valid reason for having a cabin at this location.

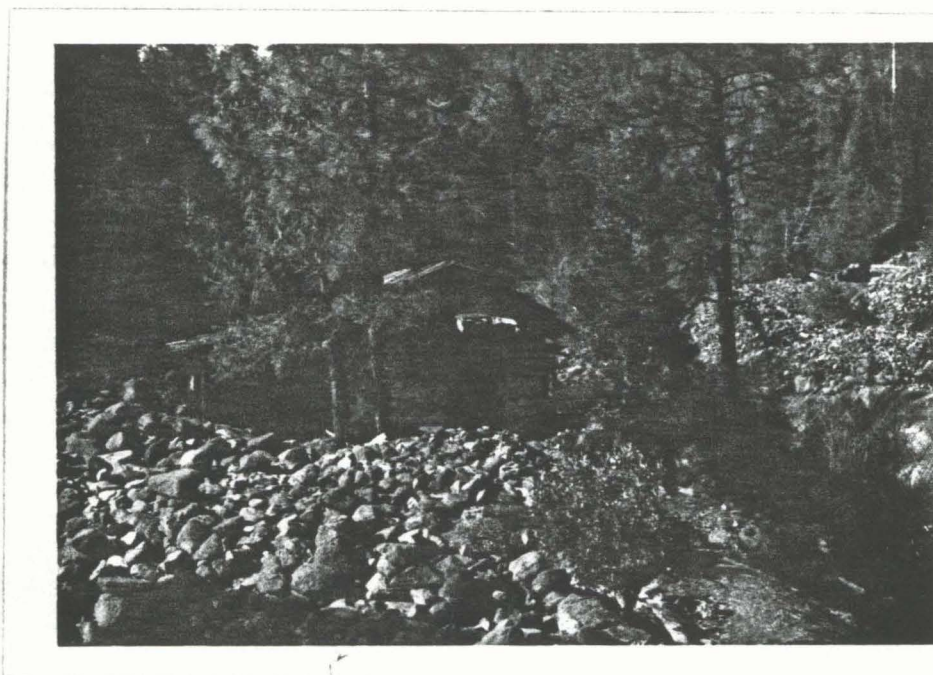
