Occupancy: There has been no steady occupancy for several years.

Mineral improvements: Piles of placer tailings

Geologic observations: Part of a middle terrace formed by an ancestral Josephine
 Creek about 30 feet higher than the present stream

Mineral valuation: The ground within the claim which can be mined by ordinary placer
 means has been worked intensively. No significant volume of gravel
 remains.

Remarks: The Ketchum cabin is the better of the two cabins on the claim. Picture 1
 shows this structure. Several years ago the claimant was living here most
 of the time. A quit claim deed granted a general half interest in the
 Enterprise claim to Hollenbeck and apparently the possession of the lower
 cabin.

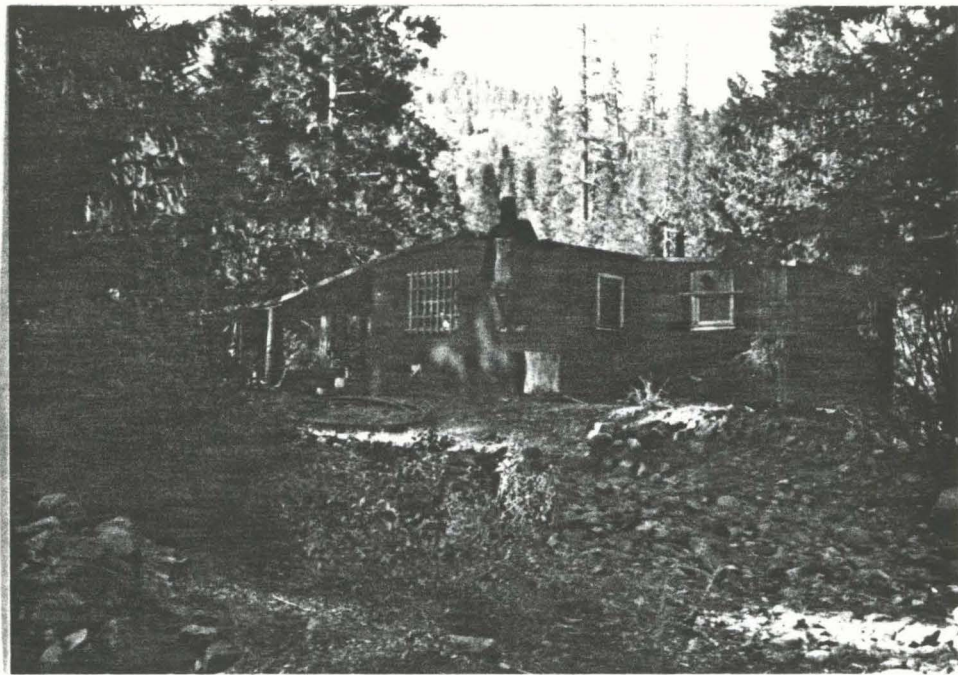
Conclusions: There is no remaining mineral potential so a cabin is not justified and
