The upper adit has about 30 tons of chromite mined out of which 15 tons is still in the chute. I would estimate that the pod is 2/3 mined out. Lower adit has been mined out, and there is no data on the size of the lens. There is about 5 tons on the dump. Total amount of ore in sight is 35 tons. Possible 65 tons.
