Area: Five claims held by location, filed at Grants Pass, Oregon.

History: This group includes two new claims, and claims of the old Bee Hive and Ingrams Claims group

Development: 100 feet of adit on the Black Point ledge. The Bee Hive ledge had between 200 feet and 500 feet of tunnel and stopes, most of which have caved.

Equipment: Cabin, blacksmith shop, steel and miscellaneous small tools. Not active at present.
