ARROWHEAD MINE (gold)

Lower Applegate area

Location: Sec. 24, T. 38 S., R. 6 W.

History: "The Arrowhead mine, 14 miles south of Grants Pass, near head of Powell Creek, is owned by Mr. Wooster, and is at an elevation of about 2,900 feet, as measured by barometer. The trail to the mine leaves Powell creek at a small reservoir. An adit extends S. 52° W. 58 paces, and thence S. 35° W. 20 paces to the breast.

The last course is on a vein of quartz, which is 4 to 15 inches wide; pyrite occurs in the quartz and also in the greenstone wall rocks."
