

We are enclosing a copy of a 1947 report on the Ajax Mine which you asked about. This report is from Bulletin 34 published by our Department and unfortunately out of print.

As nearly as we know there is no organized mining activity in that general area right now. There are mining companies exploring in southwestern Oregon from time to time and there has been some recent interest in the Almeda Mine area.

I am also enclosing a Galice geologic map which describes the geology and shows other gold occurrences and prospects in the Ajax Mine area. This map sells for \$1.50 and should you want to keep it, will you please remit.


Thank you for the 1947 report
