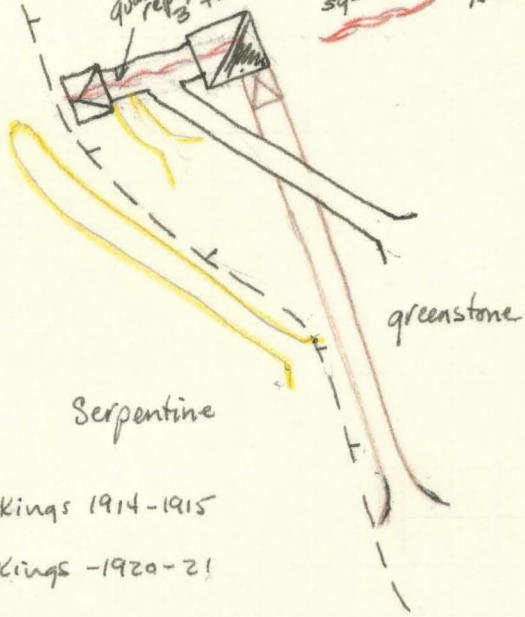

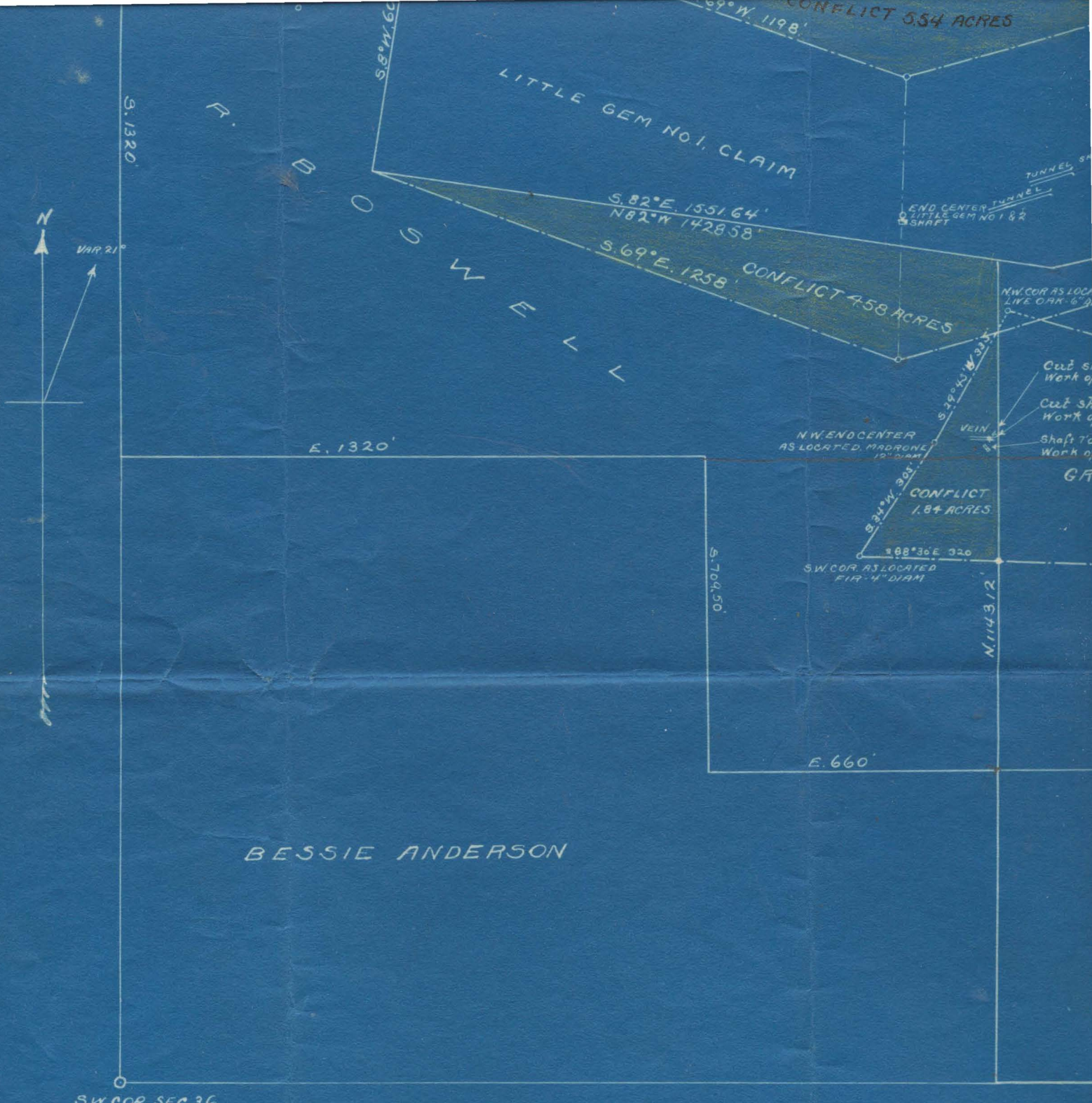

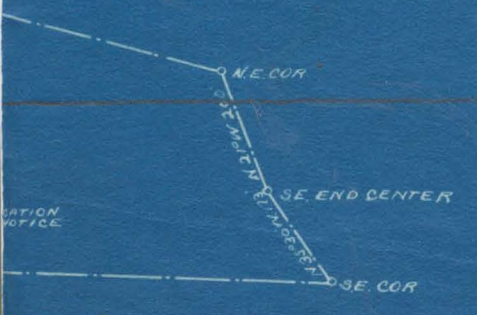
CONFLICT BETWEEN GRAND PRIZE & R. BOSWELL

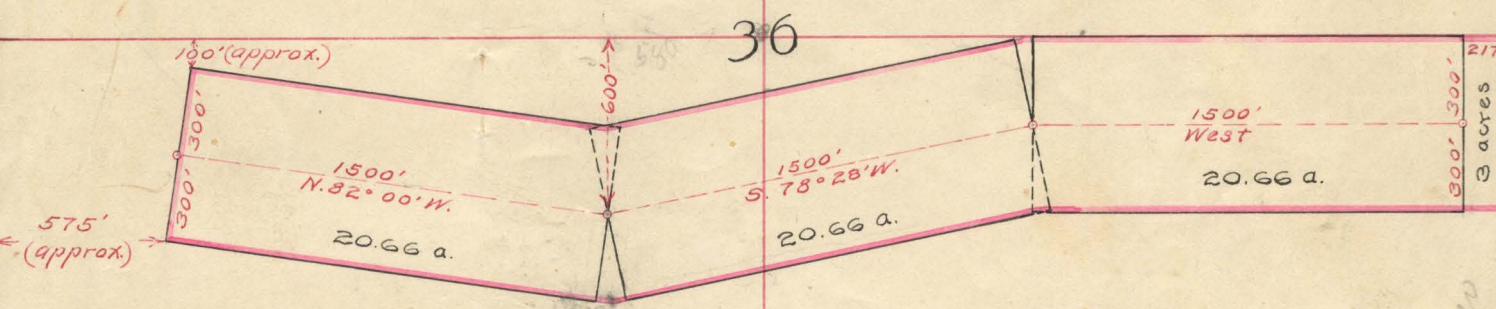

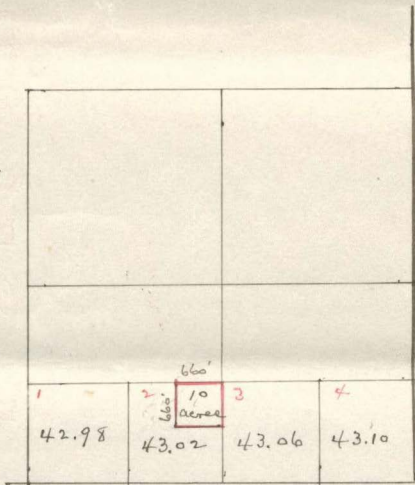
