

DAVIS CLAIMS

Waldo Area

Owner: C. H. Davis, 608 South Oakdale, Medford, Oregon.

Location: Sec. 3, T. 41 S., R. 5 W., 7 miles from passable road, west of Whiskey Peak.

Area: 5 claims.

Development: One open cut, 13 feet deep; several small test pits.

Geology: The ore is reported to consist of black oxides and rhodochrosite, and samples of the ore have been so identified. There is "some gray mineral" which may be rhodochrosite. The manganese ore occurs under a capping which can be pried off with a bar. Reports indicate a large tonnage.

(Reports of a large body of rhodochrosite ore in the Upper Applegate area have been prevalent for the last year or so. This is the first success at running it down, and this, undoubtedly, is the deposit. E. W. Webber has approved the ore samples. The deposit is 7 miles from the extreme end of a poor road up Steve's Fork of Carberry Creek, past the old Browntown--an inspection would be a 2 day job with ^a pack animal as there are no accommodations at the prospect.)

Sample A.G. 1178 assayed by A. A. Lewis showed manganese 62.2 percent.
