Name: Iron Mine.

Owner: John S. Perkins.

Location: Located on the west side of Bolan Creek about 1000 feet above Sucker Creek.

NENE Sec 30, 40S, 6W

Area: One located claim.

History: Located in 1944 by Mr. Perkins.

Development: No work has been done on outcrop.

Geology: The outcrop appears to be a mineralized and silicified zone of argillitic rocks. Zones of mineralization follow bedding planes. Minerals seen were largely pyrite and a few chalcopyrite crystals. In places the argillitic rocks were completely replaced by a cherty quartz which contained disseminated white pyrites. A sample of the outcrop submitted to the Department assayed .01 oz. gold and .12 oz. silver. Similar structure and mineralization was seen at the Hull mine on the east side of Bolan Creek.

General: Mountainous topography, considerable timber and sufficient water for mining operations.
