

According to reports, Ralph H. Burr of Cave Junction, Oregon, has leased the **Rainbow** gold mine in the Waldo district of Josephine County from H. W. Finch, 1516 Euclid Avenue, Berkeley, California. Until recently Burr was general manager for Finch on the Rainbow property. The mine was formerly known as the Siskron mine and is equipped with a 25-ton amalgamating mill. Ore is being mined from the 200-foot level and what ore remains in the upper levels is being taken out.

Development is being carried on at the Rainbow gold mine in the Waldo district of Josephine County, Oregon, which is owned by H. W. Finch, 1516 Euclid Avenue, Berkeley, California. Ralph H. Burr of Cave Junction, Oregon, is general manager, and G. M. Carroll, Box 16, Holland, is mine superintendent. A 25-ton amalgamation mill is on the ground and mine workings have been taken to a depth of 300 feet.
