There is some laterite development, but it is rather spotty with no very large areas. There are a few spots along the terraces on the north side also some on the crest of the ridge which may warrant arilling if we can't find anything better. The trouble seems to be in the multitude of large springs above 3000 televation -- these apparently have carried away most of the laterite. There is a large amount of chalcedony present.
