

CURRIER QUICKSILVER PROPERTY

Location: On the Lakeview Bend Highway just south of Summer Lake two tunnels have been driven to intersect a zone which is said to contain quicksilver. The country rock is a silicified crystal tuff cut by small cross veins composed of black breccia. There is no quartz seen. All the rock is hydrothermally altered, secondary saltpeter, and copper sulphate is abundant on the walls of the tunnel.

The equipment consists of a cabin, single cylinder compressor, engine, and two banks of retorts. Catch basins and condenser tubes. Apparently several tons of ore were run through these old retorts but almost none through the new bank.
