Received your letter of the 24th will say there are several cinnabar prospects in Lake Co. The most of them are not opened up enough to tell much about it at present.

At Summer Lake about 14 miles above Paisley* they are putting in a 35 ton retort that is 35 tons every 24 hours, everyone is anxious to see how this mine turns out before doing much on their claims in the eastern part of the County I am interested in 5 claims but cannot show them at this time. There is good showings 20 miles south of Lakeview.

There is one claim 55 miles east of Lakeview that is opened up some and possibly could be handled. Will be glad to write you later.
