Arrangements are being made with a New York group by Wendell Snow of Seneca, California, to operate his **Union** quartz mine this season. The property is located in Lane County, 40 miles east of Eugene, Oregon, in the Blue River district. Present development consists of about 1,600 feet of underground workings. Equipment on the ground includes a 20-ton mill, Chandler and Taylor side-cutting muley saw mill with a 4,000 to 6,000-foot daily capacity, and a fully equipped assay plant. About 50,000 tons of ore are stated to be blocked out. The mine has been idle since 1915.
