References used for the summary report in DOGAMI Bulletin 61 are listed on page 316 and in the Bibliography. p. 325 too. There may be some additional information in the mine files at our Portland Office; but I rather doubt it. The work by Callaghan and Buddington, 1938, is generally the most complete for deposits in the area. I believe most of the references are available In the University of Oregon Library. The map, Plate 3 in the packet of Bulletin 61 shows the main veins striking northwesterly; but it appears quite possible that one of the northeast-striking veins mapped nearby to the northeast may intersect the President Vein.
