BROWNSVILLE SANDSTONE

Linn County

A small quarry of buff-colored fossiliferous sandstone located $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of Brownsville in sec. 24, T. 14 S., R. 3 W., has been used by the art department at the University of Oregon for sculpturing purposes for many years.

The quarry covers about an acre but the tonnage of stone removed is quite small. The stone is compact and free enough from joints and imperfections in the form of fossils to permit its use for small sculptured pieces measuring not over 2 feet or so in any one dimension.
