SUBJECT: Coal Analyses


Dear Mr. Allen:

Enclosed are duplicate copies of three coal analysis reports covering the samples from Linn County, Oregon, as described in your letter of March 8.

Samples 1 and 2 contained such a high ash content that the calorific value determinations are not reported. However, it appears to us that sample 3 is of different rank from samples 1 and 2. It is impossible though to tell what rank sample 3 is actually because it was a sample of stored coal rather than a freshly mined one. I do not believe it is from the same bed as samples 1 and 2.

You did not state in your letter whether or not samples 1 and 2 were from the same bed.
