Notice hereby is given that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a vein or lode of mineral bearing rock in place upon the unappropriated public domain of the United States within the State of Oregon and said Mining District; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States, of the State of Oregon and the regulations of said Mining District, have located and do hereby located a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post at the point of discovery. The name of the claim is PIP #5053 claim, further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked Discovery Post from thence 0 feet to the E End Center Post, thence 300 feet in a SW direction to the SE Corner, thence 1500 feet in a NW direction to the SW Corner, thence 300 feet in a NE direction to the W End Center Post, thence 300 feet in a NE direction to the NW Corner, thence 1500 feet in a SE direction to the NE Corner, thence 300 feet in a SW direction to the E End Center Post. 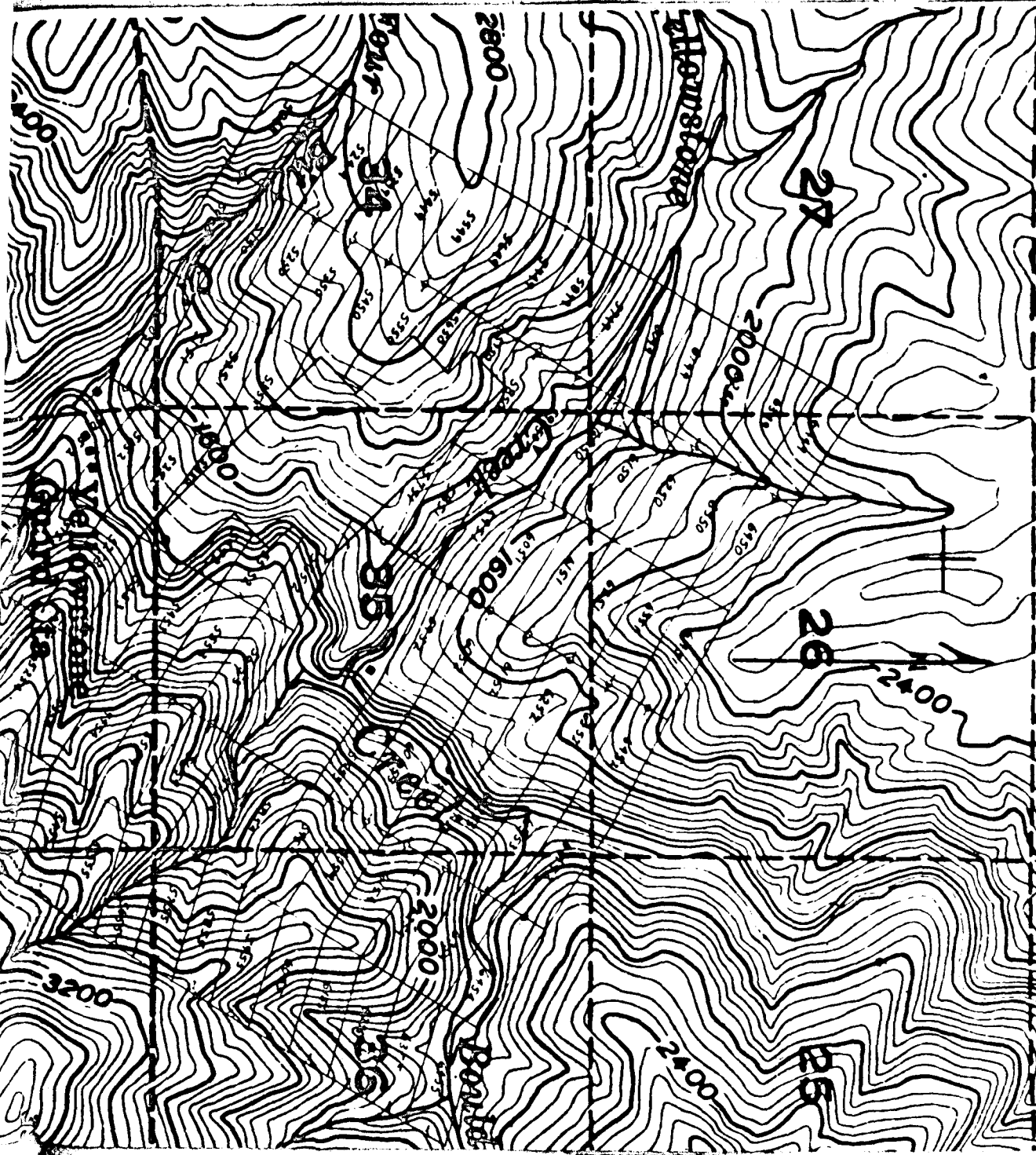
