Concerning the matter of cancelling the mine serial number 33-42, issued to the Brets mine in Oregon, as directed by you, we have written the Administrator of Mine Priorities, requesting this action.

In examining the record of mine serial numbers issued to Oregon mines, we find that two sets of serial numbers have been issued the Brets and Opalite mines. Some time last fall (the date was not sent to us) mine serial numbers 33-14 and 33-15 were issued to the Brets and Opalite mines respectively. Then later in December, I believe, at a time when you notified us that you were in need of a mine serial number, we requested the Administrator of Mine Priorities to issue your serial numbers as promptly as possible, not realizing that you already had such numbers, at least according to records sent to us.


Referring to your letter of January 12th:




We have not received our serial number, under OPM Order P-56, for the Opalite and Bretz mines.




