MEMO: September 10, 1951

Frank I. Bevier reported (Sept. 10, 1951) that he had found some gibbsite float in sec. 30, T. 8 S., R. 2 W. The locality is $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Turner and is located on the Robert Schafer farm. The property is best reached by taking the Turner-Sunnyside road from Highway 99 and proceeding east to the Schafer mail box then turning north to his home. The gibbsite is found on the knoll due north of the house.
