	Point School in only partially altered
	arkose or tuff.
7.9	Loc. No. 23 Plastic iron-stained clay in road cut.
8.5	Loc. No. 24 Gray plastic clay in road cut.
9.1	Loc. No. 25 White to red variagated clay, with varying
/ • -	degrees of alteration from arkose or
	tuff.
